- Each team is guaranteed a three (3) game minimum. The third (3rd) game will be in either pool play or single-elimination bracket play.
- Coaches and bench personnel MUST adhere to the AAU dress code: collared shirt, slacks, long khaki pants, and closed-toed shoes; no hats, no jeans, no shorts, no sweatpants, no t-shirts, nor open-toed shoes. Non-compliance can disallow coaches from sitting on the bench during their scheduled games.
- The team on the left side of the pool play schedule/top of the bracket play schedule will be the home team and MUST wear white jerseys; the team on the right side of the pool play schedule/bottom of the bracket play schedule is the guest/visitor and MUST wear black/dark colored jerseys.
- This event is sanctioned by the Amateur Athletic Union of the U.S., Inc.
- All participants must have a current AAU membership.
- AAU membership may not be included as part of the entry fee to the event.
- BE PREPARED: Adult and non-athlete memberships are no longer instant. Please allow up to 10 days for membership to be processed.
